Beyond the Bachelor's Degree

At UMW, we believe that study in the liberal arts is the perfect preparation for any profession. Students can combine their B.A. or B.S. degree from UMW with programs at partner institutions that will lead them to rewarding and successful careers.

Bachelors to Graduate Degree Accelerated Programs

Three years of study at UMW and the fourth year of combined coursework with a partner institution, to complete the bachelor's degree and begin work towards these graduate professional degrees:

- **Law:** BA to JD with the **George Mason University Antonin Scalia Law School**
- **Pharmacy:** BS to PharmD. with **Shenandoah University Bernard J. Dunn School of Pharmacy.**
- **Engineering:** BS to MS with **George Mason College of Engineering**, BS to MEng in Computer Science with **Virginia Tech College of Engineering**

Medical school and Osteopathic Medicine early admissions

UMW students who fulfill requirements, receive access to early admissions with these partners:

- The **George Washington University School of Medicine** early medical school selection with for UMW Honors Program students.
- The **Edward Via College of Osteopathic Medicine (VCOM)** guaranteed admissions interview program.

Other undergraduate partner programs

UMW students can study at these specialized programs, earning credits toward their bachelor's degree.

- **Smithsonian-Mason School of Conservation (Front Royal, VA):** work and study with Smithsonian scientists, George Mason faculty, and experts from conservation organizations around the world.
- **The New England Center for Children (Southborough, MA):** course work (offered on-site by Northeastern University and Simmons College) and supervised practicum experiences at this state-of-the-art education and individualized treatment center for children with autism and other disabilities.
