


Soft Power vs Hard Power in the Thai Monarchy

The role of kingship and calls for the reform of the monarchy have been at the center of the current ongoing struggles between authoritarianism and democracy that have kept Thailand in constant turmoil since the 2014 military coup. Traditionally, the power (amnat) of the monarchy has been understood as flowing from the meritorious virtue (barami) of the monarch. Professor Charnvit will explore the historical roots of this conception, how it has shaped Thailand's development, and what it means for an uncertain future.
