

MODERN LANGUAGES/LATIN RETROACTIVE CREDIT

The Department of Modern Languages or the Department of Classics, Philosophy, and Religious Studies, as appropriate, will award retroactive credit to any student who takes the language level based on their placement score subject to the following:

- Effective for all students who matriculate after Fall 2018. Students who entered before Fall 2018 are not eligible
- Students must successfully complete a designated course with a B- or better
- Although there is no time limit on retro-credit, students are advised to complete coursework and apply for retro-credit within their first year of completing coursework
- Taking a designated course pass/fail disqualifies students from receiving retro-active credit
- Students cannot receive retroactive credit and transfer credit
