The University of Mary Washington's BSN Completion Program (BSN-C Program) is a 30-credit program designed for graduates of an associate degree* or hospital diploma program* who hold an RN license and wish to earn a BSN degree.

Students may attend the program part time or full time.

The BSN degree at UMW requires 120 credits: Students may transfer 90 credits from their former schools.* The 30-credit BSN-C Program must be taken at UMW.
