Professor Guan-Yi Leu

Guan-Yi Leu has published research papers and contributed commentaries to the Journal of Current Southeast Asian Affairs, Issues & Studies, and Tamkang International Review. She has also authored and published chapters in several books, such as East Asian Regional Integration and Challenges [Dongya quyu zhenghe yu tiaozhan] in 2019 and The Strategic Options of Middle Powers in the Asia-Pacific in 2022. In the fall of 2023, she published a book chapter titled "The Evolutions of China's Free Trade Strategy and the Prospect after the CCP's 20th Party Congress" in the 3rd edition of Introduction to Mainland China Studies [Zhongguo dalu gailun]. She coauthored a peer-reviewed article, "A Review of China **Studies** in Taiwan: History, Development, Main Contributions," and

expected to be published in the journal *China Report* in the winter of 2024.

Professor Jared McDonald

Jared McDonald authored the book, Feeling Their Pain: Why Voters Want Leaders Who Care, which was published by Oxford University Press in 2024. Using a mixed methods approach, the book provides a framework for understanding why voters view some politicians as more compassionate than others. Professor McDonald also co-authored papers published in Political Science Research and Methods and the Journal of Environmental Psychology. His ongoing research looks at American public opinion toward lowering the voting age in elections to 16. In 2024, Professor McDonald became the Conference Manager for the Southern Political Science Association.

Professor Stephen J. Farnsworth

Stephen J. Farnsworth, Professor of Political Science and director of UMW's Center for Leadership and Media Studies is co-author of two new books: Late-Night in Washington: Political Humor and the American Presidency; and *Producing* News in Time a of Disinformation: *Information* **Evaluation** Strategies for *Journalists* and News Consumers. During **Spring** 2024, Dr. Farnsworth served as the J. William Fulbright Distinguished Scholar in Humanities and Social Sciences at the American Studies Center of the University of Warsaw in Poland.

Professor Jason W. Davidson

Professor Davidson is the College of Arts and Science's 2022-24 Waple Professor and a Nonresident Senior Fellow at the Atlantic Council's Transatlantic Security Initiative. This academic year he is conducting research for a forthcoming book on NATO after the Ukraine War.

Professor Rosalyn Cooperman

Professor Cooperman has served as Chair of the Department of **Political** Science and International Affairs since January 2022. Her book, Sell-Outs or Warriors for Change? A Comparative Look at Rightist, Political Women in Democracies (with Shauna Shames and Malliga Och, editors), was published by Routledge Press in November 2022. She serves as an Expert Contributor to the Election Watch project on congressional and state elections sponsored by the Center for American Women in Politics at Rutgers University. Professor Cooperman serves as co-chair of the Women in Legislative Studies Professional Development seminars. She is presently working on a book manuscript that examines the contributions of women legislators in the Virginia General Assembly.

Professor Ranjit Singh

Ranjit Singh remains active in a number of ways. In the field of environmentalism, his article on the ethical pitfalls of battling invasive species appeared this winter in the peer-review journal *The Trumpeter: Journal of Ecosophy*. In addition, Professor Singh's book manuscript about nature and life on Potomac Creek, Virginia, where he was raised on a family farm, is currently on submission to publishers. He is represented by the Dystel, Goderich and Bourret literary agency.

In the field of international studies, Professor Singh recently organized or participated in several events concerning the ongoing war in Gaza and the broader Middle East crisis. These include two campus teach-ins, and coorganizing a community forum titled "The Middle East Crisis: Extending Compassion and Recognizing Grief in Our Own Community." He regularly speaks about the crisis to media and community outlets.

The Virginia Conservation Fellowship program Professor Singh founded in 2021 to provide

opportunities for students of color pursuing environmental careers expanded in the last year to include applicants from George Mason University. Although he recently stepped down as chair, he continues to serve on the Board of Directors of the Northern Virginia Conservation Trust (NVCT). Protecting over 8,000 acres of conserved land, the NVCT is the second largest land trust in Virginia.

Professor Emile Lester

Emile Lester's and W.Y. Alice Chan's coauthored book, *Equipping Educators to Teach Religious Literacy: Lessons from a Teacher Education Program in the American South* was published by Routledge Press. The book presents the findings of their three-year evaluation of the Georgia 3Rs program, a pioneering initiative intended to promote respect for religious freedom and diversity in Georgia public schools.

Dr. Lester is currently completing a book examining the possibility of civility and consensus across the religious and political divide after Trump. The book draws on his travel experiences in Georgia, and examines the intersection of race, religion, and politics in the South during the Trump presidency.

Dr. Lester continues to consult with the Texas Freedom Network concerning controversial curriculum standards for Texas public schools set by the Texas State Board of Education (SBOE). He reviewed SBOE-proposed 2023 curriculum standards for history and government courses.

Professor Surupa Gupta

Professor Gupta was on a sabbatical during the 2023-24 academic year, researching and writing about the politics of agricultural reforms in India, focusing mostly on state-level reforms. Additionally, she continued to write on India's trade policy and presented her research on India's economic engagement with the Indo-

Pacific at premier universities and think-tanks in India: at the School of International Studies in Jawaharlal Nehru University, at her alma mater, Jadavpur University and at the Centre for Social and Economic Progress (formerly Brookings India). In March, she presented this research at the annual meeting of the International Studies Association in San Francisco, CA. Professor Gupta spoke to the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation, Forbes and other news outlets last year commenting on farm politics and gender politics in India.

Additionally, Professor Gupta continues to serve as the program director for UMW's Women's and Gender Studies program.

Professor Melissa Martinez

Melissa Martinez's most recent work is a publication at the Georgetown Journal of International **Affairs** called "Democratic Backsliding: El Salvador's State of Emergency and Use of Violence." The article examines how President Nayib Bukele has been working to expand his executive power since he won the presidential seat in 2019. The state of emergency accelerated his pursuit of consolidating power in the state, which has led to democratic backsliding. Moreover, the rapid erosion of civil liberties and physical integrity rights has expanded the gap that victims have towards accountability and protection from the excessive use of power. Nevertheless, there is still a ray of hope. International human rights activists have been paying close attention and have been documenting the abuses under the state of emergency. Victims of physical integrity abuse can seek support from the International Criminal Court.

Martinez was also invited to co-author a chapter with David Cingranelli for a book called "Teaching Human Rights" with Edward Elgar Publishers. The chapter focuses on domestic institutions and their relationship with human rights. In this chapter, Martinez and Cingranelli discuss questions that have emerged in the

literature surrounding the role that democracies to protect civil and political rights. They also provide insight on the limitations that these institutions have in protecting other rights including physical integrity rights and economic rights. Martinez adds some insight from her research by also discussing the role of institutions when civilians are faced with violence from non-state actors. The authors recently discussed their chapter in a small workshop at the American Political Science Association this Fall.

She has also been working on her book manuscript called "Democracy with Physical Integrity Rights." In this manuscript she examines why Mexico and Guatemala have struggled to support physical integrity rights despite their democratic transition two decades later. She not only provides an analysis on state policy and practice, but she also examines what leads to physical integrity violations at the local level and examines who is most likely to be targeted. She examines a few case studies in both countries at the national and local level.
