THEA 482: Senior Project Proposal

The Senior Project in the Department of Theatre & Dance is intended to provide a challenging experience that connects theory and practice for a student about to complete a major in Theatre. As a capstone experience of previous courses, this project should be completed during one of the last two semesters of study.

A written proposal must be submitted, along with this signed form, to the Department Chair no later than one week prior to the March department meeting in the semester preceding your senior year. This proposal should explain the project as clearly and precisely as possible and should also include the specific reasoning for pursuing this project as a cumulating experience of your major program. If you are pursuing a Senior Project that involves a departmental production, you must document your requisite experience in the production process as required by the *Senior Project Guidelines*.

Upon approval of your project, you will receive permission to enroll in THEA 482: *Senior Project*.

If you want your project considered for Departmental Honors, you must indicate your wish and eligibility on this form. The faculty will award Departmental Honors no later than the last day of classes of the Spring semester of the student's final year. Students who achieve Honors must agree to provide a copy of their Senior Project (or appropriate documentation of a creative project) in a form acceptable to Simpson Library by its announced deadline.
