Whether it be on the stage, backstage, in the box office, running a theatre, or in a variety of other professional endeavors, this is our way of letting you know what some of them have been up to since leaving their UMW home...



After graduating from Mary Washington, **Kieran Shaw '15** relied on his experience working in the Klein Theatre Box Office to secure two professional box office positions in the D.C. area—Peter Pan 360, a popular touring production of *Peter Pan*, and the Fitzgerald Theatre in Rockville, Maryland. He then became a sales associate at the Tony Award-winning Shakespeare Theatre Company where he works at both the The Lansburgh Theatre and Sidney Harman Hall. While at UMW, Kieran was seen on stage in *The Tempest, Lysistrata, Harvey, Sunday in the Park with George*, and *Lady Windermere's Fan*.

For the past 35 years, Pat Seyller '77 has been the Costume Shop Manager at the Virginia Opera in Norfolk, Richmond, and Fairfax, Va. Pat has also served as the Costume Director at the Opera Theatre of St. Louis for the last 28 years. She has designed and coordinated hundreds of productions and worked with scores of international, Broadway, and regional designers. Throughout her long career, Pat has worked at almost every major opera company in the country over the years and has even done shows in Japan and Oman at the Royal Opera House. While at Mary Washington, Pat contributed her talents to the costumes for *The Madwoman of Chaillot, The Tragical History of Doctor Faustus, The Wizard of Oz*, and *The Tempest*.





After graduating from MWC, **Robin Brumm Clayton '95** taught high school theatre and English in her home state of Maryland before moving to North Carolina. She has been the theatre teacher at Ashley High School since it opened in 2001. Robin was a founding member of the Magic Trunk Theatre Company—an educational children's theatre troupe that tours libraries and elementary schools throughout North Carolina. While at MWC, Robin worked as a costume shop assistant, building costumes for *Cloud Nine, Antigone,* and *Into the Woods*. She continues to put her costume shop experience to good use for both the high school and middle school productions, which included, in the last two years, *Emma, The Children's Hour, The Lion King,* and *The Wizard of Oz.* 

# WHERE ARE THEY NOW!

Jasmine Commerce '00 is a musician in San Diego, where she splits her time performing her own original music and providing therapeutic music programs in rehabilitation centers. In 2015 Jasmine raised over \$29k through Kickstarter to fund her first full-length album of original music. She has shared the stage with Joss Stone, Natasha Bedingfield, and Matt Costa. Her song, "Meant to Be" was released on Sony ATV's Hickory Records. Jasmine has recorded with Grammy-winning Nickel Creek artist, Sean Watkins, and has released three of her songs on Cleopatra Records.

Jasmine's YouTube channel has over 2 million views; one of her videos was featured in the Beatles' 50th Anniversary documentary, *The Night That Changed America:* A Grammy Salute to The Beatles. While at Mary Washington, Jasmine appeared in Sunday in the Park with George, Sweeney Todd, and Quilters and also worked in the box office.

After graduating from MWC, **Amy Perdue '82** worked at various theatres in the Richmond area in a wide variety of jobs, including box office, stage management, wardrobe, properties, acting, directing, and choreography. She worked as office manager and assistant to the artistic director for four years at Barksdale Theatre before she landed her current job as theatre arts specialist for Henrico County Division of Recreation & Parks. In this role, Amy serves as Artistic/Producing Director for Henrico Theatre Company, a community theatre based at The Cultural Arts Center at Glen Allen and directs an eight-week summer performing arts camp for children. Amy's directing credits include *White Christmas, Big River, Pump Boys and Dinettes, Annie Get* 



Your Gun, Guys and Dolls, Footloose, Pippin, and The Case of the Dead Flamingo Dancer. She was also thrilled to choreograph Forever Plaid for Fredericksburg Theatre Company several summers ago. During her time at Mary Washington, Amy spent many hours working the box office, danced with the MWC Dance Company and stage managed countless shows including *The Prime of Miss Jean Brodie*.



After graduating from Mary Washington, **Tim Erickson '81** pursued a graduate degree at American University and has been working in educational theatre in Tampa Bay with his wife, Lori, for the past 25 years. They established the Shark Theatre Magnet Program at Nature Coast Technical High School with honors courses in acting, directing, and technical theatre. Tim also teaches *Survey of Drama*, a dual enrollment course for Pasco-Hernando State College. Tim credits his MWC mentor, Dr. Roger Kenvin, with instilling a critical appreciation for dramatic theory and the sublime nature of tragedy. Tim's favorite directorial endeavors include Aeschylus' *Prometheus Bound*, Anouilh's *Antigone*, and Lorca's *Blood Wedding*. At MWC, Tim appeared on stage in *Look Homeward*, *Angel*, *The Wizard of Oz*, and *A Streetcar Named Desire*.


