



Internship with Joel Griffin for Senate District 27

The Joel Griffin for Virginia Campaign is seeking interns to join a data-driven campaign in one of Virginia's most competitive state senate districts of the 2023 cycle. Interns will engage in daily campaign activities with mentoring from experienced campaign staff. This internship program is designed to give students a behind the scenes view of a political campaign; experience with the skills and tools used in grassroots organizing; and opportunities for careers in campaigns and politics in the future.

This internship will be hybrid, with interns splitting time between working remote and working at our office in Fredericksburg, Virginia. Hours are flexible, and generally fall between 10-15 per week. No prior campaign or political experience is necessary to apply.

Joel is a marine veteran, community advocate, and small-business owner. After 20 years of serving his country and opening a number of small businesses, he founded a company dedicated to supporting veteran entrepreneurs. After the death of his oldest daughter, Joel and his wife cofounded Gwyneth's Gift Foundation, a nonprofit dedicated to raising awareness and educating people about CPR and the use of Automated External Defibrillators. He spent countless hours advocating and lobbying the state government to pass Gwyneth's Law, mandating CPR training in Virginia schools. Now, Joel is running for State Senate to stand up for the working families of Virginia and will fight tirelessly against the extremists in our government that threaten our peace and freedom. In the State Senate, Joel will create the good paying jobs we need; protect women's right to safe, legal abortion; strengthen and invest in our public schools; and work to reduce the cost of prescription drugs.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Contacting and turning out targeted voters through phone banking and canvassing.
- Recruiting volunteers to participate in direct voter contact activities.
- Completing projects related to the departments on finance and communications.

Qualifications:

- Strong interpersonal skills, including the ability to discuss politics and current events.
- Ability to work in a competitive, fast-paced, campaign environment.
- Experience as a proactive problem-solver.
- Enthusiasm for government, policy, and political campaigns.
