All our internships will be based in local offices in Lexington, Richmond, Charlottesville, or Nassawadox. Please see the postings for more information.

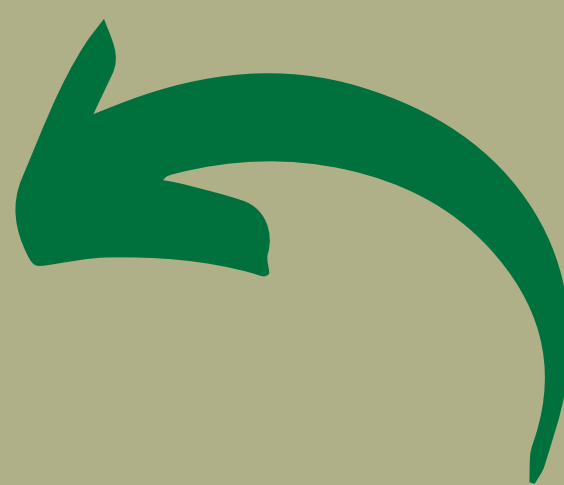
