This research, undertaken during the pandemic, examines how women workers and employers have navigated the informal economic sector in Michigan and assesses employment strategies before and during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Dr. Sejuti Das Gupta received her PhD in Political Science from the School of Oriental and African Studies, University of London. Her book, *Class, Politics and Agrarian Policies in Post-liberalisation India*, was published by Cambridge University Press in 2019.
